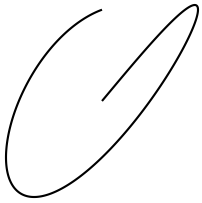


2011 – 2012 Math and Technology Academy

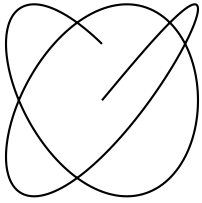

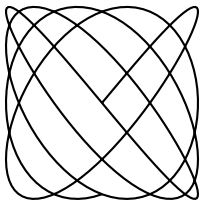

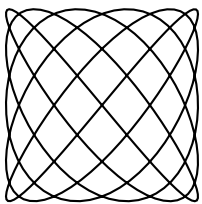
